# Are You Registered to Vote?

Historically local elections have very low voter turnout – even though the District Council is responsible for important areas of local government. So be sure that you are registered to vote. The deadline for voter registration is 12<sup>th</sup> April. The easiest way to register is via the SNDC website.

Remember that if you are not able to get to the Polling Station, you can apply for a postal vote via the SNDC website before 15<sup>th</sup> April.

If you are interested in standing for election to the Parish Council your nomination form needs to be submitted to the SNDC offices in Long Stratton. The deadline for submitting is 4pm on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> April.
